Prior to the 2011 NSW State elections the Community Justice Coalition (CJC) made a submission to the political parties asking them to commit to a list of major reforms designed to make the justice and the prison systems more just, effective in rehabilitating prisoners, lowering the recidivism rate, making the systems more socially effective and less costly, and to cease participating in the media "law and order" campaigns which led to the doubling the prison population at a time when the crime rate was falling.
